



Student Access Goal: All Coloradans shall have access to comprehensive community college education programs.

- CNCC fall enrollment is slightly above last years although several off campus sites are not yet registered as high schools are starting later this year.
- CNCC is offering two new online associate degree programs this year: Power Plant Technology and Banking.

Student Success Goal: The demands of Colorado businesses and communities shall be met through the development of a high skilled workforce.

- CNCC is expanding the school-to work program in a partnership with Delta-Montrose Technical College.

Student Success Goal: Colorado students shall have seamless opportunities to transition from high school into college and from two-year institutions into four-year institutions.

- CNCC is aggressively working with business and industry in developing workforce training. We are also in talks with Delta-Montrose Technical College on a partnership in creating a regional mine training center.
- CNCC is pursuing an agreement with CSU in establishing a Natural Resources Center of Excellence at the Rangely Campus.

Student Success Goal: Colorado students shall have the opportunity to succeed through high quality, cutting edge instruction and educational services.

- CNCC has increase full-time instructor ratios by better schedule management.

Operational Excellence Goal: The financial stability of the system's institutions and the physical safety of its students shall be ensured.

- CNCC is in its first major gift campaign. The tentative campaign goal is \$8.3 million dollars; the college has currently raised over \$7.1 million. The goals include a career and technical building, a wellness center, renovations of two buildings, program enhancements, and support for our three satellites.

- The Craig Campus has just completed design development for phase I and is on schedule to bid in early January.
- The Rangely Campus is completing the \$6.5 million energy audit. These improvements are greatly improving campus conditions for our students and employees.
- The Rangely Campus is in progress on three projects; the Striegel Engineering Center, the ADA and Security Upgrade, and an emergency bridge replacement going into the Weiss building.
