POLICY STATEMENT

The statutory prescribed role and mission of state system community colleges is to "...offer a broad range of general, personal, vocational, and technical education programs... To fill the occupational needs of youth and adults in technical and vocational fields, to provide two-year transfer educational programs to qualify students for admission to the junior year at other colleges and universities, and to provide a broad range of programs of personal and vocational education for adults." 23-60-201, C.R.S.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all state system community colleges.

INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION

State system colleges are authorized to affiliate with the Commission on Institutions of Higher Education of the North Central Association.

PROCEDURES

The System President shall promulgate such procedures as may be needed to implement this policy.
