

On June 26, CCCS President Dr. Nancy McCallin, announced that Dr. Bert Glandon will be leaving Arapahoe Community College by the end of this month. He has accepted the position as the second president for the College of Western Idaho.

He has served as president of ACC since 2002. His appointment at CWI marks a return to that area, where he was the president of Treasure Valley Community College in Ontario, Oregon, from 1993 to 2002.
