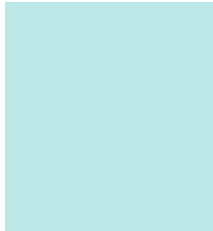

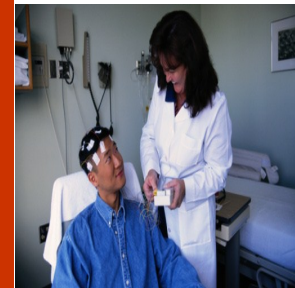

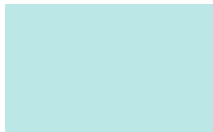

TAA Eligible, Veterans, and Other Adults:

Priority enrollment includes those eligible under the Trade Act of 1974, as amended, TAA for Workers program, United States Veterans as per the Jobs for Veterans Act, and other dislocated workers and low-wage earners.



Program and Courseware Development:

Short term, stackable and latticed, hybrid and online allied health programs and courses are being developed incorporating NANSLO technology, support services for students, and professional development for faculty. The project design uses evidenced based models that ensure transferable and articulated courses with four-year institutions.

Nurse Aide Certificate; Home Health Aide; Medication Aide; Hospice Aide; Home Health Care Aide, Pharmacy Aide; Licensed Practical Nursing, Associate Registered Nursing; Polysomnographers; Emergency Medical Services including Paramedicine and EMT, ; Medical Laboratory Technology; Radiological Technology; Associates of Applied Science; Phlebotomy Certification; Health Information Technology including Certified Coding Specialist and Health Information Technician AAS degree; and a Health Care Core Certificate.

NANSLO Labs:

North American Network of Science Labs Online builds remote labs using open source software and a robotic interface to allow students to remotely control actual lab equipment and perform lab exercises in real time while gathering valid and reliable data.



Improved Employment Outcomes:

Processes are being developed for internships, career coaching, and building strong partnerships with committed employers for career placement, employment outcomes are improved. Comprehensive employment service are developed through an integrated career hub that includes campus, industry, and local workforce partners.
