<u>Application</u>

This guideline applies to the state system of community colleges.

Principle

Designates parameters for Academic Renewal.

Guideline

- 1. A maximum of 30 hours can be excluded from the GPA.
- 2. Courses and grades approved for Academic Renewal remain on the transcript but are excluded from the GPA calculation/s.
- 3. Academic Renewal applies to D and F grades only.
- 4. In order to apply for Academic Renewal, students must wait a minimum of 2 academic years from the last term being considered for Academic Renewal.
- 5. Students must be enrolled and have completed at least 6 hours with a 2.0 term GPA to be awarded Academic Renewal. For a Reverse Transfer Degree only, the student may fulfill this requirement, by demonstrating enrollment in at least 6 credit hours with a 2.0 term GPA during last semester of attendance at the four year institution.
- 6. Students can only apply for Academic Renewal once, and it is not reversible.
