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Day 1 **Feedback** on Common Measures

- At a high level, the common measures seem appropriate, but the devil is in the details
- Grantees are interpreting the DOL “common” outcome measures differently
- Wording for common measures need tweaked for non-credit programs (and to account for the varying definition of full-time/part-time students)

Day 1 Feedback (continued)

- Guidance is inconsistent among different FPOs
- Three categories of grantees
 - Some have current measures in place and it is not politically feasible to revise
 - Some would find it both useful and potentially feasible to develop and implement common measures
 - Some have measures currently set, but could augment common measure
- Grantees are happy to share materials they have developed with others to help out and for feedback

- Rephrase common measures to better incorporate non-credit programs and variability in full-time/part-time program
- Work with grantees on common measures, as appropriate
- Formally communicate your feedback on common measures to Gates
